### **Meeting Overview:**

Molly Graham welcomed everyone and reviewed the agenda. There were no changes to the previous meeting summary. A PowerPoint presentation was delivered by Ann Jamison and Tim Chan. Ann presented the BART Project overview and milestones. Tim described Preliminary Engineering field activities, the role of the community working groups, and next steps. The presentation was followed by an open public discussion. Comments from CWG members are as follows.

### **Key Issues/Comments on the BART Extension to Milpitas, San Jose and Santa Clara:**

#### Station Design:

- Clarify when the Berryessa station area planning will be discussed and when stakeholder/property owner involvement will occur.
- VTA should provide maintenance to ROW now that the UPRR tracks have been acquired.

#### General:

- Ridership appears to be a significant issue with VTA and Federal Transportation Authority (FTA). Consider providing more information on ridership projections to the public.
- Explain the process of condemning property in regards to the status of EIS/EIR certification.
- Clarify whether the schedule of the Warm Springs Extension is related to the separation of the EIS and EIR.
- Clarify whether noise and vibration testing was done at Five Wounds Church.

- Consider holding small meetings with major stakeholders and encouraging involvement from property owners.
